Diagnosis at Examination: Osteosarcoma; Left

Surgery:

- S/P Orthopedic surgery NOS (left):
Node: ;Wide resection + tumor prosthesis on tibial side: 18/06/2014

Primary Complaint: The patient underwent excision of the left proximal tibia with insertion of prosthesis in the tibial side only on 15/06/2014. Today his cast was opened and the drain was removed. The surgical wound is normal. There are no motor or sensory deficits noted.

Mapping: Poor / no response for chemotherapy: 55%.

Surgical margins are free from tumor.

Examination:

Patient is able to ambulate without aids.

Surgical wound is normal.

No motor or sensory deficits in the distal aspect of the extremity.

Summary and Treatment Plan: At this stage he will continue his activities with his knee fixated, without mobilization of the knee!!!!!!

Recommendation: Follow up in 3 months with current X-ray.
